



We are now ready to open for students starting this Monday, June 1st. Teachers have contacted parents and arranged what days their children will be attending. Students have been assigned to either Monday/Tuesday or Wednesday/Thursday.

Please be sure you have received the following information from your child's teacher:

- your drop off and pick up times
- line-up locations
- As a precautionary measure, and to support the safety of the public and our employees, Watson Elementary is temporarily closed to public walk-ins. To make an appointment, please call the school office at 604-858-9477 between 8:00am and 2:00pm Monday to Friday. **Only students and staff are permitted in the building**
- students only need one pair of shoes – no changing shoes
- water fountains are closed – students can bring a labeled water bottle – students can refill bottles here
- we are encouraging outside time – parents should apply sunscreen to their children
- hats and sunglasses
- no stuffies or toys
- parents should notify the office if their child is absent or late
- report to front doors if you arrive late

Students are to make their way **directly to their line up spots** in the morning (playgrounds will be closed) and students are to be picked up or walk home (parents should let teachers know if child is walking home) **immediately after school**. Supervision staff will be sending kids home.

Before sending your child(ren) to school parents are required to do a daily health assessment for your child(ren) before coming to school. Families are asked to keep their children at home if they have any of the following symptoms: cough, sneeze, fever, sore throat, headache, feeling unwell, fatigue, chills, aches and pains, diarrhea, nausea/vomiting, or difficulty breathing. **If a child has seasonal allergies, they should let their teacher know.**
