The stage needs decorated by December 6. Inquiring about lights and music for outside. Do we want to add these purchases to the budget? Speakers are approximately \$250. The admin is thinking about buying a speaker with a mic for the school. Single line item for winter decorations for \$300 was approved in a vote. Perhaps for an inflatable or light-up (for waiting outside the school on Winter concert night).

Any ideas to sell flowers (roses for \$1 a piece) and give to students after their performance. Maybe an idea for the talent show.

Baby-sitting course on a pro-d day will be discussed at a later date.

Principal's Report

Ease parent night went well – approximately a dozen or so parents attended.

Staffing – hired 2 permanent EA's, but 1 is leaving for a different school. Currently hiring for 3 EA's (1 permanent and 2 temp). Just hired a NHS.

Elementary Numeracy Collaboration is coming to Watson in November and February to help teachers improve their practice.

Early Literacy Collaboration – someone is coming in on Friday to help with improvement in reading for the younger grades. Writing is an area that needs a lot of support.
