Chair Report

December recap:

Other requests were made but there would need to be many more volunteers to make more happen.

Holiday cheer – a few parents volunteered with homemade baked goods, and it was well received by staff.

Hampers – the PAC is happy to help families of our school in need during the holidays. We budgeted \$1,500 for this for 14 families. We had a few grocery stores around town donate items and an anonymous donor who gave \$715 that allowed many more items to be purchased. This 40+ item hamper may not be replicable in the future because of the donor's help this year. However, the PAC would like to continue making holiday hampers.
